Financial Update: Based on estimates of both giving and expenses through the end of August 2018, and using \$25,000 from the bequest funds to cover the Associate Pastor's salary, it appears that income should meet operating expenses for Springdale's fiscal year. However, **this does NOT include giving to missions.** Of the \$32,465 budgeted for missions, \$27,851 remains unpaid. Therefore, any income beyond anticipated giving by August 31 will help reduce this deficit, providing needed funds for these valuable ministries (see 2017-2018 Spending Plan for details - copies available in the literature rack). Thank you to all who have supported Springdale this year, and please prayerfully keep this in mind as you plan your giving through the end of the fiscal year.

Recommendations from the Auricle Team will be distributed to the congregation next Sun., July 29. A **Congregational Meeting** will be held on Sun., Aug. 5, after worship, to review and offer feedback on these recommendations; and a vote will be held on Sun., Aug. 19.
